**SOUTH CAROLINA LOTTERY COMMISSION’S CONSENT
MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO FILE BRIEF OF RESPONDENT**

Pursuant to Rule 263(a), SCACR, Respondent South Carolina Lottery Commission, by and through the undersigned counsel, respectfully requests an 11-day extension of the August 24, 2020 deadline to file its Brief of Respondent in the above-captioned appeal. The undersigned counsel consulted with opposing counsel prior to filing this motion, and counsel for Petitioner George S. Glassmeyer has no objection to this request.

This is Respondent’s first request from the Court for an extension of the deadline for filing its brief. See Rule 242(i), SCACR (providing respondent shall file and serve copy of its brief 30 days after petitioner serves and files its brief). Although the undersigned counsel recently finished reviewing the numerous briefs in the record, he has also had to comply with several expedited

briefing deadlines—both in this Court and in the U.S. District Court for the District of South Carolina—in urgent matters relating to, among other things, the upcoming general election on November 3, 2020. Therefore, the basis for this request is that the undersigned counsel, who was retained after the Court granted certiorari, requires additional time to ensure the brief is properly researched and prepared in this matter. With this modest extension, the brief would be due on September 4, 2020. Respondent does not anticipate any further extension requests.

For the foregoing reasons, counsel for Respondent respectfully requests that the Court grant this motion for an 11-day extension to file the Brief of Respondent for good cause shown and in the interests of justice.
