Dear Chief Justice:

I am an state prisoner confined to the Department of Correction, SC (SCDC) serving a(n) twenty-year sentence to which I went to trial and was found guilty of armed robbery and possession of a(n) weapon convicted on February 20th, 2020. However, my court appointed attorney file notification with the intent to appeal on March 23rd, 2020.

The sole purpose of this letter by correspondence is to inform you of the State delay causing and subjecting me to inordinate delay. I've been awaiting on a(n) indigent appellate defense lawyer who has of yet not corresponded to me and address my concerns. I've wrote Director Rosalyn Frison to obtain a(n) copy of my court transcript to perfect the appeal. I've written the Court Reporter to request a court copied transcript raising indigency to which I am. prison officials adverse conduct towards me in which I did grove the reasonable officials concerning this matter. However, this issue among the other issue of not receiving a(n) free copy of my trial transcript is causing me trouble to raise and/or present a(n) viable defense or an substantive claim whereas the failure of neither correspondences are not being adequately and properly addressed.

I cannot communicate with my trial court-appointed attorney, nor the indigent of defense attorney whom I have as of yet not spoken with due to the loss of my property violating my due process of law. If You Will, Please alert the proper and responsible officials so that I can meet the AEDPA (Anti-terrorism and Effective Death Penalty Act) statute of limitations to file a(n) Federal Habeas Corpus Writ. Please contact me to let me know what to do next.
