## ORDER

---

Respondent Kimberly M. Morrow has filed a motion to seal this appeal, arguing personal information, including her social security number, is "scattered throughout the documents that are submitted."

As set forth in the Supreme Court's order *RE: Interim Guidance Regarding Personal Data Identifiers and Other Sensitive Information in Appellate Court Filings*, 375 S.C. 56, 650 S.E.2d 462 (2007), parties shall not include, or shall partially redact, personal data identifiers, including social security numbers, names of minor children, financial account information, and home address, from documents filed with an appellate court. Our review indicates the record on appeal does include personal identifiers, and it is troubling to this court that Appellant failed to redact the record as required by the Supreme Court's order. Accordingly, within twenty days, Appellant shall amend all copies of the record filed with this court and redact all personal identifiers referenced in the Supreme Court's order.

Appellant has filed a motion to strike portions of Respondent Kimberly Morrow's final brief and the appendix that was attached to her initial brief. Appellant's

motion is granted. Within twenty days, Respondent shall file an amended final brief that is identical to Respondent's initial brief except for references to the record and corrections to typographical errors and misspellings. *See* Rule 211(b), SCACR. Respondent shall also exclude all references to the appendix. Furthermore, because Respondent's appendix is stricken, Appellant shall file an amended final reply brief that omits any reference to the appendix.
