MOTION AND ORDER

PLEASE TAKE JUDICIAL NOTICE, that the Petitioner, Nathaniel Johnson Jr #211574, an pro-se litigant who hereby move for an Order Authorizing Funding for DNA Testing Hearing Transcript, for an court appearance held on 11/15/18.

Petitioner is indigent and according the United States Supreme Court ruling in the case of * Ake v. Oklahoma, 470 U.S. 78, 84 S.Ct. 53, 105 S.Ct. 1087 (1985), Petitioner, asserts that he is entitled by right to resources from the indigent defense fund, that he may be provided with the necessary funding to supply his transcript for appeal. Also, see * Griffin v. Illinois, 351 U.S. 12, 76 S.Ct. 585 (1956), where under the Fourteenth Amendment, the Petitioner, is entitled to Due Process guarantee of fundamental fairness and should not be deprived because of his economical status.

Now therefore, for good cause shown, it is ordered that the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense is hereby ordered authorization for funding to provide transcript.

It is further ordered that the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense is authorized to incur reasonable fees, therefore, not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125.00), subject to the approval of this Court as authorized by law, without further order of this Court, Mr. Johnson, may apply to this Court for further relief if necessary, in pursuant to §17-3-50(c), Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976 as amended.
