

DEAR CLERK:

In 2019 or early 2020, I wrote a request to the Dentist, requesting dental implants due to loose, broken, and missing teeth, from being assaulted by correctional officers, and taking chemo-therapy. The dentist denied my request. I wrote and filed a grievance. The step 1 portion of the grievance was denied. I filed a step 2 grievance and I have not received a response. I asked the grievance coordinator about the grievance and I was told that ~~to~~ ~~about~~ I had to wait until General Counsel respond. However, its been more than 90 days and I hadn't received a response albeit my due diligence in seeking one. My teeth hurt me when I chew, my gums hurt, I have no front teeth and my head constantly hurts, and my breath smells after I try to brush what I have left in my mouth. I would like to appeal the warden's decision or ask that this Court ~~compel SCDC to~~ ~~or~~ order SCDC to comply with my request, because SCDC violated my rights guaranteed by the United States Constitution, to petition for a redress of grievances and subjecting me to cruel and unusual punishment by neglecting me necessary dental care pursuant to Civil Rights of Institutionalized Persons Act §§ 2-12, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 1997-1997; 28 C.F.R. §§ 40.1 to 40.22.

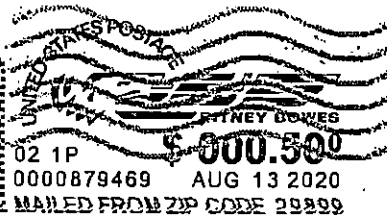
