(B) PETITIONER WROTE TO THE CLERK OF COURT ON APRIL 1ST, 2020 CONCERNING RECEIVING A COPY OF THE MARCH 18TH LETTER, AND HAVING FAILED TO RECEIVE NOTICE OF ENTRY

(C) THE RESPONSE DATED "4/13/20" WAS: "OUR OFFICE CANNOT SEND SOMETHING WE HAVE NOT YET RECEIVED. PLEASE BE ASSURED WHEN WE RECEIVE THE ORDER WE WILL SEND YOU A COPY. SINCE THE COURTS ARE OPERATING UNDER THE COVID-19 GUIDELINES WE MAY NOT RECEIVE YOUR ORDER FOR A FEW WEEKS OR MONTHS"

PETITIONER RECEIVED ON AUGUST 13TH, 2020, A COPY OF

THE COURT'S ORDER, DATED AUGUST 10, 2020 (COPY PAGE 4) AND RESPECTFULLY SUBMITS THIS PETITION PURSUANT TO RULE 221 (a), (c) SCACR. AS TO THE POINTS SUPPOSED TO HAVE BEEN OVERLOOKED OR MISAPPREHENDED BY THE COURT:

(1) THE "NOTICE OF APPEAL" WAS SERVED ON APRIL 17, 2020, WITHOUT A COPY OF THE FINAL ORDER BECAUSE OF:

(b) THE APRIL 1ST LETTER SHOWING PETITIONER'S KNOWLEDGE OF THIS WHICH WOULD HAVE RAISED AWARENESS BY THE CLERK OF COURT AND OR HIS OFFICE

(c) THE APPROPRIATE RESPONSE BE TOWARD AN INVESTIGATION INTO WHY THE ORDER HAD NOT BEEN RECEIVED IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH RULE 71.1 (f) AND 77 (d) SCRCR. PARTICULARLY THE PROVISION OF RULE 77 (f) THAT HOLDS (IN PART) "IN POST-





