MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Walter Murrey respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days, from August 26, 2020 until September 25, 2020**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.

2. Counsel for Walter Murrey respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time, **including managing an office and a full, heavy personal caseload during the coronavirus. In addition, counsel consults with four less-experienced appellate defenders on all of their cases and reads all of their filings in**

advance. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. William Derek Bennon with this Court on August 21, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of William S. Pegues v. The State with the Supreme Court on August 21, 2020. Counsel is lead counsel, and is presently working on *the death penalty case* of State v. Timothy Jones Jr, where the transcripts are 7,422 pages long. Counsel has already identified at least eight issues to raise on appeal in this case, and this brief is due to be filed with the Supreme Court on September 16, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in *the death penalty case* of The State v. Jerome Jenkins, Jr. with the Supreme Court on July 13, 2020 with co-counsel Kathrine Hudgins and Adam Ruffin. Counsel is also preparing the petition for rehearing in case of The State v. Deshanndon Markelle Franks, which is due to be filed with this Court on August 27, 2020. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jason Carlton Booth with this Court on July 27, 2020. Counsel filed the Brief of Respondent in the case of The State v. Joseph Bowers with the Supreme Court on July 22, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to this Court and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Justin Jamal Warner with the Supreme Court on July 20, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Arsenio D. Colclough with this Court on June 25, 2020. **Counsel has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender, including management of the work from home personnel during this coronavirus pandemic, and the Appellate Practice Project with this Court. Counsel regrets the necessity of this extension request, but it is absolutely necessary under the circumstances.**

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the extended thirty-day general consent granted by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through August 31, 2020. That extended, emailed general consent was dated July 30, 2020.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty (30) day extension from August 26, 2020 until September 25, 2020**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the brief be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


