MOTION AND ORDER

PLEASE TAKE JUDICIAL NOTICE, THAT THE PETITIONER, NATHANIEL JOHNSON, JR. #211574, AN PRO-SE LITIGANT WHO HEREBY MOVE FOR AN ORDER AUTHORIZING FUNDING FOR DNA TESTING HEARING TRANSCRIPT, FOR AN COURT APPEARANCE HELD ON 11/15/18. PETITIONER IS INDIGENT AND ACCORDING TO THE UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT RULING IN THE CASE OF *AKE V.
