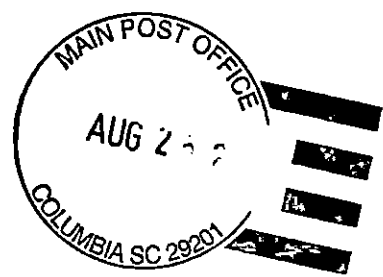

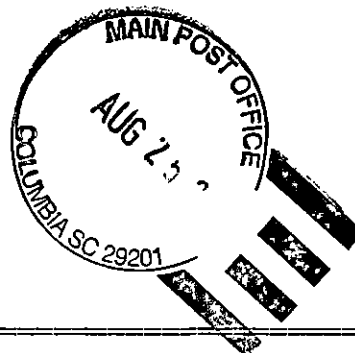

a.) Why did Richie D. Barnes, the respondent state for the record that he was not present when the fraudulent lease was signed.



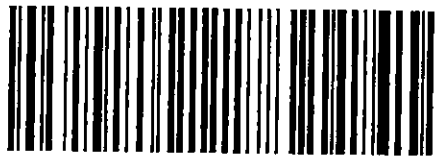
