ORDER

Appellant has served and filed a notice of appeal from the master-in-equity's order denying Appellant's motion to set aside default and the entry of judgment and foreclosure. Appellant has also served and filed an emergency petition for writ of supersedeas, requesting that this court stay the sale of the homestead, which is currently scheduled for September 8, 2020. Given the current circumstances, the motion is granted to the extent that the sale shall be temporarily stayed for five days to give Appellant the opportunity to file the appropriate motion with the master-in-equity. *See* Rule 241(d), SCACR ("Except where extraordinary circumstances make it impracticable, an application for an order lifting the automatic stay or for supersedeas must first be made to the lower court or administrative tribunal which entered the order or decision on appeal.").
