STATEMENT OF ISSUES ON APPEAL


The Appellant, Mary L. Dinkins, Higher Learning Academy, hereby gives notice of appeal from the judgment of the South Carolina Administrative Law Court, Honorable Shirley C. Robinson, presiding, in the above action.

Notice of Appeal is made subsequent to Order of Judgment entered on March 1, 2013 and received on 3rd day of March, 2013.

Appellant's exceptions to the judgment of the Administrative Law Judge are set forth as follows:

- I. The Administrative Law Judge erred when she held the Charter of the Mary L. Dinkins Higher Learning Academy was lawfully revoked under section 59-40-110 of the South Carolina Charter School Act (South Carolina Code of Laws Annotated 1976);
- II. The Administrative Law Judge erred she failed to hold that the South Carolina Charter Act is unconstitutional in its provision which allows a charter school sponsor be both the accuser and finder of fact in a charter revocation hearing under section 59-40-110 (C) of the South Carolina Charter School Act (South Carolina Code of Laws Annotated 1976);
- III. The Administrative Law Judge erred when she held that the revocation hearing by the District was held within the time limits imposed under the South Carolina Charter School Act (South Carolina Code of Laws Annotated 1976) and
- IV. The Administrative Law Judge erred when she held that the South Carolina Charter School District did not violate other provisions of the South Carolina Charter School Act (South Carolina Code of Laws Annotated 1976) in its decision to revoke the charter of the Mary L. Dinkins Higher Learning Academy?


