MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



On July 31, 2020, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Carnell Davis with the Court of Appeals. On July 23, 2020, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Nyquan Tykie Brown with the Court of Appeals. On July 15, 2020, counsel filed the brief of petitioner in The State v. Jonathan Donell Rhodes with the Supreme Court. On July 13, 2020, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Samuel Hawkins, Jr. with the Court of Appeals. On June 26, 2020, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Marquille Rondale Livingston with the Court of Appeals.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On August 26, 2020, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through September 30, 2020.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty-day extension, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
