MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SERVE AND FILE REPLY BRIEF

Petitioner hereby moves pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, for a 10-day extension, to September 24, 2020, of the time in which to serve and file Petitioner’s reply brief. The grounds for this motion are that there is good cause to grant the requested extension, as the following shows:

1. The reply brief is presently due on Monday, September 14, 2020.
2. Petitioner’s undersigned counsel has had a heavy workload this week. This week, he has had a number of writing deadlines, including for filings that took substantial time to write, such as a federal district court response to a motion for summary judgment and a reply brief in the Court of Appeals that was filed minutes ago, and he has had a

number of court appearances, including oral argument in the Court of Appeals this morning and a Common Pleas motion hearing this afternoon. Up until a few hours ago, he was preparing for a bench trial set for Monday (the case settled a little after noon today), and he has depositions tomorrow that will likely take most of the day.

3. Petitioner's counsel has not had time to review Respondent's brief and draft a reply brief, and he is not likely to have sufficient time to do so by the current deadline for the reply brief.
4. Petitioner requests a 10-day extension of the present deadline, which should be sufficient time to get the reply brief written.
5. This is the first extension sought of the subject deadline.
6. Respondent's counsel consents to the extension sought.
7. Accordingly, Petitioner believes there is good cause to grant the requested extension.
8. The undersigned has served this document on opposing counsel by email to registered AIS email address on the date given below.

WHEREFORE Petitioner prays for an order granting a 10-day extension, to September 24, 2020, of the time in which to serve and file Petitioner's reply brief.
