APPELLANT'S MOTION TO EXTEND BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Appellant James G. Wiles hereby moves this Honorable Court for an Order extending the time for appellant to file his Opening Brief until November 15, 2020. The grounds for seeking this relief are as follows:

1. 



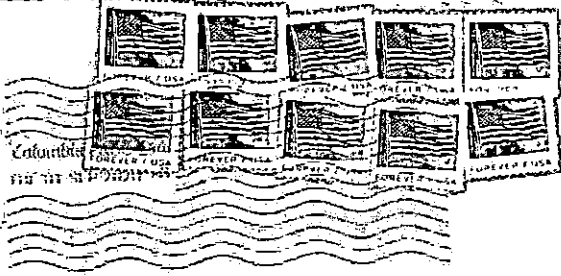
