Dear Counsel:

Under Rule 207(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), petitioner was required to order the transcript of the proceedings within ten (10) days of the service of the notice of appeal. To date, you have not provided any evidence that the transcript has been ordered.

South Carolina Court Administration records indicate the transcript was ordered on July 9, 2020, and delivered on July 15, 2020. If that information is correct, the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix were due to be served and filed by August 14, 2020. *See* Rule 243(d), SCACR.
