3.) THE CO-VID 19 CORONA VIRUS PANDEMIC HAS CAUSED MANY INMATES AND STAFF MEMBERS TO BE COME INFECTED HERE AND HAVE TO BE HOSPITALIZED AND SENT OUTSIDE ALONG WITH THE OFFICERS ALSO THAT THE OFFICER MUST STAY WITH THEM (24) HRS.

A DAY, WHICH HAS A CAUSE AND EFFECT THAT DIRECTLY AFFECT ME

4.) THE STAFF (SECURITY) HERE AT BROAD RIVER CORRECTIONAL IN-  
STITUTION ARE ALSO CONTRACTING THE CO-VID-19 CORONA VIRUS ALSO  
WHICH ALSO ADDS TO THE SHORTAGE OF OFFICERS WHICH ALSO HINDERS  
ANY OPPORTUNITY OF AN ESCORT TAKING ME TO THE LAW LIBRARY, WHEN  
AND IF IT'S OPEN.

FOR THE REASONS THE APPELLANT REQUEST A (30) DAY EXTENSION
