ORDER


Petitioner's application for post-conviction relief was denied by Judge R. Lawton MacIntosh. No notice of appeal was filed. Petitioner now seeks a writ of certiorari from an order issued by Judge Edward W. Miller granting Petitioner a belated review of Judge MacIntosh's order pursuant to *Austin v. State*, 305 S.C. 453, 409 S.E.2d 395 (1991).

Based on the vote of the panel, the court grants the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Miller's order, dispenses with further briefing, and proceeds with an *Austin* review of Judge MacIntosh's order.

The petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge MacIntosh's order is denied.
