Upon reviewing your second motion for extension, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your motion will not be considered:

- The title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title should read as follows:

Shante Michele Eugene, Respondent,

v.

South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles, Appellant.

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The content of your motion is incorrect. Your client is the respondent, not the appellant. The title of the document that you are requesting an extension for is the Respondent's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter, not the

Petitioner's Reply Brief. An amended second motion for extension will need to be served and filed.
