
Now, please find enclosed a copy of a 2<sup>nd</sup> letter sent to Ms. Amy Hill, Esquire, counsel for Respondents Allison Williams and First Federal Bank in the above referenced case regarding the service of their Initial Brief, again asking counsel to send me their brief(s) and updated certificate of service, via USPS mail. Until such time, I am unable to reply.

Further, due to the COVID situation, I have very limited access to a computer for personal use, no internet or printers so am unable to reply until a physical copy is in hand. Though this issue may be relatively moot, it is just to stress the importance of obtaining such a copy.

In regards to Respondent Collins' designation of matter (Designation Attached) in the above referenced case, #9 needs to be corrected. His designation incorrectly states the order denies the motion to hold him in default, but the order actually denies the motion requesting default *judgment* (Referenced order attached). Appellant has sent a request to Respondent Collins to correct his designation of matter and refile (Letter Attached), though it may be something only this Court has the power to direct. If so, I respectfully ask this Court to do so.


To date, I have not yet received a reply or the brief(s). If you would be so kind to send the brief(s) and an updated certificate of service, I thank you in advance.
