ORDER

The State moves to supplement the appendix in this post-conviction (PCR) relief matter to include documents that were attached to the State's return to respondent's PCR application before the circuit court. The State also moves to permit the inclusion of a copy of the recorded 911 call that was played during the PCR hearing, but not entered as an exhibit during the hearing, as well as a transcript of the 911 call. Respondent consents to both motions.

The motion to supplement the appendix is granted, and the supplemental appendix is accepted as filed. The motion to permit the inclusion of a copy of the recorded 911 call and a transcript of the call is also granted. The State shall file a copy of the recording and a transcript of the recording within ten days of the date of this Order.
