Dear Mr. Braxton:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption shall contain the name of the appellate court where the document is to be filed ("Court of Appeals"), the name of the tribunal from which the appeal is taken ("Administrative Law Court"), the name of the administrative judge, the appellate case number, the title of the case, the title of the document, and the name and address of the counsel submitting the document. No other information shall be on the title page. The title of the case should read as follows:

Ryan Braxton, #380443, Appellant,

v.

South Carolina Department of Corrections, Respondent.

- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- A table of contents is to be included in the initial brief, pursuant to Rule 208(b), SCACR.
