

ORDER

The South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal in this matter after conducting a review under *Anders v. California*. *State v. Gainey*, Op. No. 2012-UP-057 (S.C. Ct. App. filed February 1, 2012) (Appellate Case No. 2009-138826). Although counsel for petitioner has been granted several extensions to file a petition for a writ of certiorari, counsel now indicates that these extensions were sought in error and that counsel will not be filing a petition for a writ of certiorari. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. *See also State v. Lyles*, 381 S.C. 442, 673 S.E.2d 811 (2009) (this Court “will no longer entertain petitions for writs of certiorari where the Court of Appeals has dismissed an appeal after conducting an Anders review.”).
