- due to my medication I could not fully understand and did not follow what was actually happening.

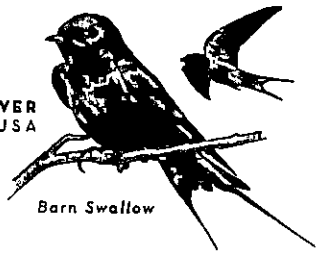
