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

( 1 ) I, Shemuel Yisrael, the Defendant, appearing pro se, do object to the Status Conference concerning the above cited cases being held in Jasper County. **MOTION TO DISMISS**

Respondent, through its undersigned counsel, would respectfully show unto this Court as follows:

I.

On June 11, 2019, Appellant filed his Notice of Appeal with the South Carolina Supreme Court, and it was later transferred to the South Carolina Court of Appeals. The language of the Notice of Appeal indicates it is an appeal of the denial of his objection to a change of venue.<sup>1</sup> Specifically, it states: "Shemuel Yisrael, appeals the verbal order denying his motion, namely 'Defendant's Objection to Change of Venue to Jasper County' . . . ."

II.

Orders regarding change of venue are interlocutory and not immediately appealable. See Breland v. Love Chevrolet Olds, Inc., 339 S.C. 89, 94, 529 S.E.2d 11, 14 (2000) ("Requiring a

defendant to wait until after trial to appeal the issue of proper venue is the most appropriate course to take where any error in that decision will not prejudice the defendant anymore than other interlocutory orders which, if in error, would require a new trial.”); S.C. Code Ann. § 14-3-330 (Supp. 2018) (Allowing an interlocutory appeal only of “[a]n order affecting a substantial right made in an action when such order (a) in effect determines the action and prevents a judgment from which an appeal might be taken or discontinues the action, (b) grants or refuses a new trial or (c) strikes out an answer or any part thereof or any pleading in any action”).

III.

The appeal in this case is clearly interlocutory and should be dismissed with the matter remanded to the circuit court to allow the case to proceed to trial.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that the Court hold this matter in abeyance until ruling on this motion, dismiss the appeal, and remand for trial; and for such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.

**Background:** On Wednesday, 13 November 2019, I received the attached document (Exhibit A) that required a response. I have researched the appeal, which was dated 1 June 2018, and the following response is provided:

1. I have no recollection of the alleged motion made by plaintiff. This appeal was not received by anyone in the Magistrate's Office until the week of November 11, 2019, approximately 18 months after it was filed.
2. While it would be conjecture, I can say that if such a motion was presented at Bond Court, I would deny the motion as it would be inappropriate to address it at that hearing. The purposes of Bond Court are primarily to (a) inform the defendant of his rights, and (b) set bond. I believe that I would have had no jurisdiction to entertain such a motion.
3. The charges that had been placed against the defendant were two General Sessions offenses and two offenses that needed to be heard in Yemassee Municipal Court. All four charges were arrest warrants generated by the Town of Yemassee, signed by a Judge from that jurisdiction and countersigned by a County Magistrate for service within Beaufort County.


**Additional Comments:**

1. Upon receiving this appeal, I contacted the office of the Clerk of Court to ascertain what information that office had on the cases listed in Exhibit A. Copies of all Bond paperwork are provided, (Exhibit B), including the completed application for the Public Defender, filled out by me and signed by the defendant.
2. Also attached (Exhibit C) are copies of subsequent documents regarding the two General Sessions charges:
  - a. Warrant 2018A2520500019 (Littering over 500 pounds) was dismissed by the Solicitor's Office on 3 March 2019 by the Solicitor's Office.
  - b. Warrant 2018A2520500020 (Failure to Stop for Blue Light) was "True Billed" by the Grand Jury on 18 October 2018. The case number is 2018-GS-07-00702.
  - c. On 6 March 2019, Chief Justice Donald Beatty issued an order vesting the Honorable Roger M. Young with exclusive jurisdiction to hear and dispose of three GS cases including the one noted in paragraph (b).
3. I have no information on the status of the municipal charges.

**Amendment I [1791]**

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

**Amendment II [1791]**

A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

**Amendment III [1791]**

No Soldier shall, in time of peace be quartered in any house, without the consent of the Owner, nor in time of war, but in a manner to be prescribed by law.

**Amendment IV [1791]**

The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.

**Amendment V [1791]**

No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a Grand Jury, except in cases arising in the land or naval forces, or in the Militia, when in actual service in time of War or public danger; nor shall any person be subject for the same offence to be twice put in jeopardy of life or limb; nor shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself, nor be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use, without just compensation.

**Amendment VI [1791]**

In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury of the State and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, which district shall have been previously ascertained by law, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; to be confronted with the witnesses against him; to have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor, and to have the Assistance of Counsel for his defence.

**Amendment VII [1791]**

In Suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed twenty dollars, the right of trial by jury shall be preserved, and no fact tried by jury, shall be otherwise re-examined in any Court of the United States, than according to the rules of the common law.

Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.

**Amendment IX [1791]**

The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people.

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
