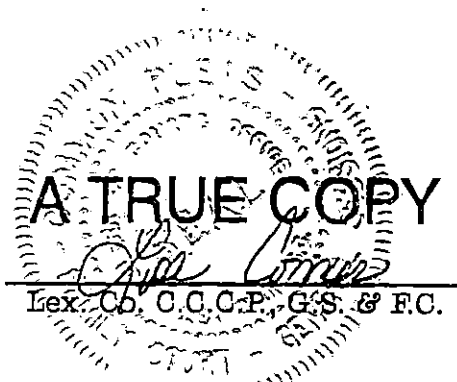

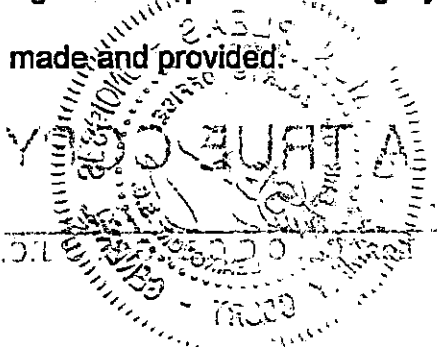

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On 02-21-19 at approximately 07:44 am, the defendant, Joseph Randolph Henry, did with malice aforethought kill the victim, Alexis Azarigian by shooting her. The defendant threatened the victim saying, "I'll kill you" before shooting the victim in the head. The defendant then fled the scene on foot. The victim died as a result of her injuries on 02-22-19. Law Enforcement obtained voluntary statements from several witnesses and photographed the scene. This incident occurred at the 3900 Block of Augusta Rd., which is in the West Columbia area of Lexington County South Carolina. The case number for this incident is 19003503.
