**Motion for Extension of Time to File Cross-Petition for Writ of *Certiorari* and  
Return to the State’s Petition for Writ of *Certiorari***

In this capital case, Jerry Inmon<sup>1</sup> moves this Court for an order extending the time to file his cross-petition for a writ of *certiorari* and return to the State’s writ of *certiorari* until Monday, November 23, 2020. This motion is Mr. Inmon’s second request for an extension to file his petition for a writ of *certiorari* and first request to file his response to the State’s petition for a writ of *certiorari* pleading since this Court’s order dated August 24, 2020 appointing undersigned counsel.<sup>2</sup>

This request is not intended for delay. Ms. Holt continues struggling with grief from the loss of her eldest child. In the last thirty days, Mr. Grose filed the petition for writ

of certiorari in *George S. Branham, II v. State of South Carolina*, Appellate Case No. 2018-001926, a petition for rehearing in *Crenshaw v. Erskine College*, Appellate Case No. 2018-001926, a petition for writ of certiorari in the Supreme Court of the United States in *Durant v. South Carolina*, and a Rule 59(e), SCRCP motion in *Spade v. State*, Case No. 2017-CP-42-02372.

Contemporaneously with this extension request, Mr. Inmon is filing a motion for an order requiring the State of South Carolina to file a Supplemental Appendix to include in the Appendix copies Applicant's Exhibits 47-54, which are deposition transcripts introduced during the evidentiary hearing.
