Grand Jurors of Spartanburg County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE- ATTEMPTED MURDER

That Jimmy Dean Williams, Jr did in Spartanburg County on or about November 8, 2019, with malice aforethought attempt to kill Jimmy Dean Williams, Sr. by stabbing the victim, with the intent to kill the said victim, in violation of §16-03-0029, of THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, (1976, as amended).

COUNT TWO- POSSESSION OF WEAPON DURING VIOLENT CRIME

That the defendant Jimmy Dean Williams, Jr did in Spartanburg County on or about November 8, 2019, visibly display a firearm and/or knife during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, to-wit: attempted murder, in violation of Code §16-23-490, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, (1976), as amended.
