I hope this letter reaches you well. You were the PCR counsel for William Pearson on 9/18/17, and I wrote am currently his attorney on appeal of the denial of his PCR application.

The Court of Appeals requested that SCCID or the Attorney General send to it a dash cam video that Pearson stated was admitted as an exhibit during his PCR hearing. Our office and the Attorney General's office have reached out to the clerk of court in Aiken county to obtain the dash cam video,
