MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Jamel Dajour Williams respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from October 28, 2020 until November 30, 2020**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court Wednesday, October 28, 2020. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.

2. Counsel for Jamel Dajour Williams respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Patrick Dean Lowrance v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 5, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Gary R. Thompson v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 1, 2020. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jonathan Johnson v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 23, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Rickey Dean Tate with this Court on September 16, 2020. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Rashawn Tremayne Carson v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 8, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Travis A. Lee v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 8, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jeffery James Williams with this Court on September 2, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Joe Lewis Holmes v. The State with the Supreme Court on August 28, 2020.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the extended thirty-day general consent granted by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through October 31, 2020. That extended, emailed general consent was dated September 28, 2020.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from October 28, 2020 until November 30, 2020**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that the time limits for filing the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


