MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Fred Jack Sanders respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until December 4, 2020**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.

2. Counsel for Fred Jack Sanders respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Andre Deshawn Posey with the Court of Appeals on September 16, 2020. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Shaquille Dozier with the Court of Appeals on September 4, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Eric T. Spears v. The State of South Carolina with the United States Supreme Court on August 28, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Darrin Houser with the Court of Appeals on August 26, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Michael Wiggs with the Court of Appeals on August 26, 2020.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the thirty day general consent granted by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through November 30, 2020. That emailed general consent was dated October 28, 2020.


