expired on June 29, 2020. Therefore, the petition for rehearing is untimely. Further, when no timely petition for rehearing was filed, the remittitur was sent to the circuit court on July 7, 2020. Rule 221, SCACR. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).

Accordingly, no action will be taken on your petition for rehearing by this Court.
