**MOTION TO ALLOW FILING OF
SUPPLEMENTAL RECORD ON APPEAL**

Respondent (“the State”), through its undersigned counsel, would respectfully show unto the Court as follows:

I.

On July 24, 2020, the State filed and served its Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter. In its Designation of Matter, the State properly designated for inclusion in the Record on Appeal: (1) specified pages from two different transcripts, including page 127 from the June 2012 plea hearing transcript; (2) all twenty-two Charleston County indictments; (3) all eleven Berkeley County indictments; (4) all fifteen Dorchester County indictments; (5) both notices of appeal; and (6) a number of other documents related to Appellant Louis Neal ReVille’s appeal that is currently pending before this Court.

II.

On September 22, 2020, Appellant served and filed the Record on Appeal. However, in doing so, Appellant appears to have inadvertently failed to include in the Record the Appeal as presently filed several of the documents designated by the State in their entirety. Specifically, the Record on Appeal as presently filed does not contain: (1) page 127 from the June 2012 plea hearing transcript; (2) a complete copy of Charleston County Indictment # 2012-GS-10-01978; (3) complete copies of all fifteen Dorchester County indictments; and (4) the second notice of appeal, which was filed on July 10, 2019.

III.


Because properly designated matter was inadvertently omitted from the Record on Appeal, the State believes it is necessary to file a Supplemental Record on Appeal containing the inadvertently omitted matter. See Rule 210(c), SCACR (“The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209[.]”). Accordingly, the State asks this Court to permit and accept the filing of a Supplemental Record on Appeal containing the designated matter inadvertently omitted from the Record on Appeal.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that this Court will allow the State to file a Supplemental Record on Appeal; accept the filing of the State’s Supplemental Record on Appeal; and for such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
