ORDER

Respondent-petitioner moves to compel the State to supplement the appendix in this capital post-conviction relief (PCR) matter to include copies of depositions that were introduced as exhibits before the circuit court. Petitioner-respondent (the State) requests that, if the motion is granted, any order specify the original exhibits remain sealed and the Court allow the sealed depositions to be transported to the Court as exhibits. In his reply, respondent-petitioner urges the Court to adopt the State's recommendation.

The motion to compel the State to supplement the appendix is granted. Within twenty (20) days of the date of this order, the State shall supplement the appendix to include copies of the depositions. Respondent-petitioner shall serve and file his petition for a writ of certiorari within thirty (30) days of service of this supplemental appendix. The State's request that the exhibits be transported to this Court is granted. The Clerk of this Court shall issue an order pursuant to Rule 210(f), SCACR.
