RE: Deposition request regarding your private instruction session with Public Official Armstrong and her Charleston County Office related to your ORDER ENJOINING PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF, case 2018-CP-10-03315, as it relates to cases other than case 2018-CP-10-03315

Judge Murphy,

Late last Wednesday afternoon, 28 October 2020, I attempted to file an amended Certificate of Service with Public Official / Clerk of Court Armstrong and her Office located at 100 Broad St., Charleston, SC 29401 for cases 2014-CP-10-05407 and 2017-CP-10-04031. As you may have guessed, they refused to file said amended Certificate of Service citing your ORDER ENJOINING PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF, case 2018-CP-10-03315 as the reason.

What was new, at least to me, is the heavy set 50ish lady with reddish brown hair who quickly brought me a copy of your ORDER ENJOINING PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF, case 2018-CP-10-03315 (her description is required since she refused to provide her name) while returning my amended Certificate of Service, stated that you had provided Ms. Armstrong and her Office a verbal briefing on your ORDER ENJOINING PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF, case 2018-CP-10-03315. It was clear from Public Official Armstrong's employee's statements, that the verbal explanation you provided Ms. Armstrong and her office about your ORDER ENJOINING PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF, case 2018-CP-10-03315 was such that it clearly applied to cases 2014-CP-10-05407 and 2017-CP-10-04031.

Given this new information, over a year after when all of this started brewing in October 2019, I am sending this letter requesting your attendance at a deposition so that you can provide the same explanation of your ORDER ENJOINING PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF, case 2018-CP-10-03315 under oath, and obviously recorded, as it relates to any case other than case 2018-CP-10-03315.

Also, beyond the requested explanation, I will be asking for you to provide the date you provided this verbal explanation to Public Official Armstrong and her Office, who was in attendance, where this verbal explanation took place, when it took place, how and why it was scheduled, the date it was scheduled, copies of all material provided during this verbal session, and of course, who was invited and who actually attended. I'm sure you and your attorneys, etc. get the picture.

I've copied as many of the people I can think of at the moment who is involved in this stuff but I'm sure I've also forgot some. Consequently, everyOne, please feel free to pass along to whoever you would like and would also be interested in attending this deposition and making any and all necessary inquiries of Judge Murphy on this very important topic. I'm one of those types that believes the more the merrier.

If we can't do this without a subpoena or something similar just let me know and we'll figure something out soon. BUT, I trust you also see both the value and requirement to provide the same explanation of your ORDER ENJOINING PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF, case 2018-CP-10-03315 to the rest of the world that you obviously found necessary to provide to Public Official Armstrong and her Office employees sometime in the last thirteen months.

Please let us know soonest your willingness to help deal with this very important issue as quickly as possible. I trust you and Mr. Wilson can determine the best path forward for South Carolina, the Rule of Law and Justice quite quickly.

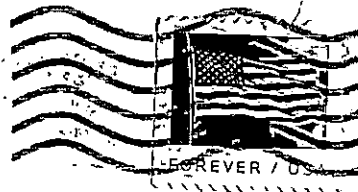
