RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION

Respondent hereby moves for a third extension of time to file the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. In support of this motion, Respondent submits the following:

1. The Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation are due March 20, 2013, pursuant to a second extension. Respondent moves for a third extension, which is not made for the purposes of delay, but due to a heavy caseload, as well as time out of the office on business.

2. Since the second extension was granted, the undersigned filed one Brief of Respondent and two Returns to Petitions for Writ of Certiorari in the South Carolina Supreme Court. She also filed one Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation, and two Final Briefs of Respondent in this Court..

3. In addition to her regular case load, the undersigned supervises the Attorney General's Office's Sexually Violent Predator (SVP) Unit and the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force grant. In her capacity as supervisor of the SVP Unit, she is required on a daily basis to address multiple issues involving sexual predator cases, including legal issues in pending

commitment and annual review cases, and she handles all sexual predator appeals. In connection with the ICAC grant, the undersign assists in preparation of grant proposals and budgets, attends meetings of national and state ICAC personnel, and supervises an ICAC grant program manager, an investigator, a forensic examiner, and an Internet Safety Education Coordinator. Since the second extension was granted, the undersigned presented at two ICAC training sessions for South Carolina ICAC investigators, and attended a Department of Justice sponsored meeting of all ICAC commanders in San Diego, CA.

4. The undersigned assures the Court completion of this brief is a high priority, and she will work diligently to complete it in a timely manner and without further extension requests. She has consulted with opposing counsel and is authorized to advise the Court that counsel does not oppose the requested relief.

Based on the foregoing, Respondent respectfully requests a third extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter, and that all deadlines be held in abeyance pending resolution of this motion.




