COMES NOW, BRYANT T. COOPER, PRO-SE IS FILING THIS NOTICE OF APPEAL ON A DENIAL OF A EXPUNGEMENT THE PETITIONER HAS FILED IN THE 10TH CIRCUIT. IN THE COURT OF GENERAL SESSIONS. THE PETITIONER IS APPEALING HIS EXPUNGEMENT DECISION. THE 10TH CIRCUIT SOLICITOR OFFICE STATED THAT THE PETITIONER DOES NOT QUALIFY TO HAVE THE ABOVE CHARGE EXPUNGED. UNDER SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS SECTION 56-5-750(F) STATES THAT AFTER A CONVICTION PURSUANT TO SUB-SECTION (B)(1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, THE PERSON MAY, AFTER THREE

YEARS FROM THE DATE OF COMPLETION OF ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF HIS SENTENCE FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE. IT ALSO STATES THAT IF THE PERSON HAS HAD NO OTHER CONVICTION DURING THE THREE YEAR PERIOD FOLLOWING THE COMPLETION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SENTENCE, THE COURT SHALL ISSUE AN ORDER EXPUNGING THE RECORDS. THE PETITIONER COMPLETED HIS PROBATION ON AUGUST 26, 2011, THE PETITIONER HAS HAD NO CONVICTIONS IN THOSE THREE YEARS AFTER HIS PROBATION SENTENCE ENDED IN 08-26-2011, THE ONLY CONVICTION THE PETITIONER HAS RECEIVED IS ON AUGUST 16, 2017, SIX YEARS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF HIS SENTENCE PROBATION. THE PETITIONER IS ELIGIBLE FOR EXPUNGEMENT ACCORDING TO SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS SECTION 56-5-750(F) AND SUBSECTION (B)(1). THE PETITIONER ASKS THE HONORABLE COURT TO EITHER GRANT AN ORDER TO EXPUNGE THIS CASE FROM HIS RECORD OR TO ORDER THE

COURT OF GENERAL SESSIONS IN ANDERSON COUNTY 10TH CIRCUIT  
TO EXPUNGED THIS CASE OF FAILURE TO STOP FOR BLUE LIGHT-  
FIRST OFFENSE.

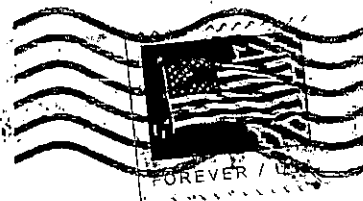
