**ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR

On or about September 8, 2020, Plaintiffs filed a timely motion pursuant to Rule 59(e) SCRCP to reconsider its Order dated August 28, 2020.

After reviewing and considering Plaintiffs' motion, the Court is of the opinion that the motion requests the Court to reconsider only findings of facts. The Court held an informal status conference in the virtual courtroom and inquired whether the Plaintiffs' had suggested that the court needed to reconsider any errors in the application of the law. The Plaintiffs suggested that the court reconsider whether it had considered any adverse inferences which may be considered in weighing of the evidence by the factfinder when a party fails to call a witness with knowledge of facts in a contested case. This Court finds that it considered all testimony and evidence in the case including any adverse inferences in making its findings of fact and conclusions therefrom. The Court found that the Plaintiff did not prevail in its burden to prove its case by a greater weight of the evidence.

Since no issues of any misapplication of the law were raised in the motion, the Court finds that a hearing on the motion to reconsider would not assist the court in ruling of the motion.

Therefore, the Court respectfully denies Plaintiffs' motion for reconsideration.
