Dear Honorable Mr. Shearouse,

Thank you for your timely response to my letter dated October 22, 2020, and I hope this letter finds you in good health and spirits.

As I previously stated I have been attempting to file a writ of Mandamus. I seek to have a court order the circuit court in Horry County to rule on my Motion For Mistrial and Motion For New Trial both of which I filed before being sentenced on September 16, 2020. However, on September 16, 2020 Judge William Seals refused to hear or rule on either motion, and refused to allow me to speak even though I appeared without counsel, and signaled the bailiffs to remove me when I tried to do so.

Further, since that time I filed a timely notice of appeal, and motioned for the appointment of counsel, but as of the date of this writing I have not heard anything.

I am seriously concerned as the S.C.D.C. policies prevent me from following the rules of court. How can I proceed if I am not allowed copies? Honorable Sir, not only is my conviction wrongful, but I didn't commit the crimes either. I am innocent of the charges!

Finally, Sir S.C. Code of Law Title 17, Section 17-30 state the Court of Appeals had authority to hear my Writ of Habeas Corpus. So does S.C. Code of Law Title 14, Section 8-290. However, the clerk rejected it. Therefore, I petitioned for Writ of Certiorari.

Is the Court considering my Petition for Writ of Certiorari, and if so has it been assigned a case number? Would you please tell me where it stands at this point.

Sir, I would love to be able to afford an attorney, but I have been beat down, robbed, abused, and even tortured by Horry County government officials over the past decade. I simply have nothing left but my life, and now they are seeking to take that

without ever even allowing me to be heard, or even speak for that matter. How is that even possible in our country? Honestly, sir, is this what our courts have come to?

Thank you for your time! I know you are a busy person, but please inform me as to the status of my petition for certiorari, and one last thing please. May I file a Writ of Habeas Corpus with the Supreme Court seeking access to the materials I need to proceed in court? Thank you and God Bless!

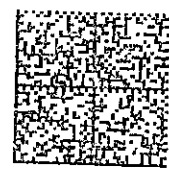
