(WHEREUPON, there were no exhibits marked during this hearing.)

P R O C E E D I N G S

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THE COURT: Okay.

THE PROBATION AGENT: Your Honor, this is Frazier Singleton, Frazier Singleton.

He was sentenced by Judge Seals on Indictment 2016-GS-43-00009 for the offense of stalking when an injunction or restraining order is in effect prohibiting contact. He was given 10 years, upon the service of five years, suspended, with three years probation. No contact with the victim upon release. The financials are as shown on the face of 1106.

We are here today because he pled guilty to habitual traffic offender here in Sumter County General Sessions on 6/5/19, and received a sentence of five years, upon the service, I'm sorry, upon time served with balance suspended to one year probation.

Additionally, he pled guilty to DUI in Sumter County General Sessions on that same date, and received a sentence of 90 days upon time served, balance suspended, one year probation. He also failed to pay his supervision fees. He failed to pay his surcharge, and he never followed up with vocational rehabilitation. There's a stack of missed appointments in your packet, Your Honor, and the agent has a letter from the counselor which details his lack of

1 progress.

2 Also he violated Condition Number 10 by attempting to
3 contact the victim upon release. This is a direct violation
4 of the Court Order, and then, Your Honor, we scheduled him
5 for Court by way of a citation. He failed to appear, and
6 yet failed to appear clearly because of his own will. I
7 mean we have a copy of the 1364 that tells him the date of
8 Court, the time, and everything else.

9 But, Your Honor, more so, when you take a look at this
10 person's criminal history, this is more than just a habitual
11 offender. I mean he -- his criminal history's all over the
12 board, and, Your Honor, it just astounds me that the only
13 way that he was caught was he was arrested in Kershaw County
14 for driving under suspension, which just two months prior
15 or, I'm sorry, two and a half months prior, he actually
16 passed me on Highway 521 running in excess of 90 miles an
17 hour. How I know, because I was doing in excess of 80 miles
18 an hour, and he was caught by the Sumter County Sheriff's
19 Department here, had a couple bench warrants, and that's
20 what kept him in jail.

21 And, Your Honor, this is just not a case where
22 probation is fruitful for him. I think it would benefit him
23 to go ahead and finish his sentence in the Department of
24 Corrections, and it will benefit our Department to be able
25 to put the time and effort that we've put into him into

1 someone who could benefit from it.

2 THE BAILIFF: Raise your right-hand, sir.

3 (WHEREUPON, the Defendant complies.)

4 THE BAILIFF: State your full name.

5 THE DEFENDANT: Frazier Singleton.

6 (WHEREUPON, the Defendant was placed under oath at this
7 time.)

8 THE COURT: Tell me about contacting the victim now.

9 MR. LITTLE: Beg, beg the Court's indulgence.

10 THE PROBATION AGENT: I have an affidavit here, Your
11 Honor.

12 You want to see this?

13 MR. LITTLE: I've seen it before.

14 THE PROBATION AGENT: All right. Your Honor, may I
15 approach?

16 THE COURT: Yes, sir.

17 (Pause.)

18 THE COURT: Okay.

19 MR. LITTLE: Sorry, Your Honor.

20 THE PROBATION AGENT: Yeah, let me---

21 MR. LITTLE: We're trying to---

22 THE PROBATION AGENT: Yeah, let me ask the Judge if I
23 can see his rap sheet.

24 THE COURT: You want to see his rap sheet?

25 MR. LITTLE: Your Honor, before I address the

1 individual allegations in there, I think I need to let the
2 Court know of -- sort of the complicated procedural history
3 to this case.

4 Back in June, Your Honor, the Solicitor's Office and I
5 had tried to work out a negotiation of some sort of plea
6 offer on the habitual traffic offender, and he was charged
7 with DUI second offense. I, at the time, forgot that
8 Mr. Singleton was on probation. So, Ms. McElveen offered
9 him probation, and Judge Seal went along with the
10 recommendation back on June the 5th. This triggered his
11 probation violation, and he was served with a citation for
12 that.

13 We were suppose to bring him back the following day for
14 the probation hearing and to resolve this. Ms. McElveen and
15 I had talked about asking the judge to reconsider the
16 sentence. Unfortunately, the jail forgot to bring him that
17 day, and Judge Seals had to leave.

18 Mr. Corbitt and I -- Mr. Jason Corbitt and I went back
19 and talked to the Judge about this case, and he advised us
20 that he was comfortable with another circuit judge
21 reconsidering the sentence. They brought him back the
22 following week on June the 10th in front of Judge
23 McFadden, and we were going to try to resolve it at that
24 point. However, even, even though his current probation had
25 been violated by the plea, Mr. Singleton denied at the time,

1 and still denies, having had contact with the victim, and
2 Judge McFadden advised us that we needed to have a full
3 evidentiary hearing on that particular issue of the
4 probation violation.

5 THE COURT: Uh-huh. (Affirmative).

6 MR. LITTLE: That was what was suppose to be heard in
7 September, on the 13th.

8 Mr. Singleton admittedly did not come to Court that
9 day. He tells me that he was working in Myrtle Beach doing
10 construction work at the time. Judge, I know that's, that's
11 not an excuse, but that's, that's what happened.

12 He did, he did pick up that charge in Kershaw County,
13 which I believe is still pending. He was arrested there on
14 November the 23rd, and he was brought down to Sumter on
15 the 27th where he has been ever since.

16 THE COURT: And what's the charge in Kershaw?

17 MR. LITTLE: I believe it's driving under suspension
18 or, or---

19 THE COURT: Okay.

20 MR. LITTLE: It's some sort of driving offense.

21 Beg the, beg the Court's indulgence.

22 (Pause.)

23 MR. LITTLE: And, Your Honor, he -- other than the
24 Kershaw County charges, he has not picked up any other
25 charges, at least in Sumter County, that I'm aware of. He

1 may of had some outstanding from somewhere else.

2 THE PROBATION AGENT: Your Honor, can I show these to
3 Mr. Little prior to giving them to you?

4 THE COURT: Yeah.

5 On the 13th, when he didn't show, was the victim
6 here?

7 THE PROBATION AGENT: No, sir.

8 THE COURT: Why not?

9 THE PROBATION AGENT: We sent her a letter, Your Honor.

10 THE COURT: She didn't come?

11 THE PROBATION AGENT: No.

12 MR. LITTLE: Apparently, Your Honor, he does have the
13 habitual traffic offender warrant for Sumter County that's
14 pending. He has not, to my knowledge, been served with
15 that. I don't represent him on that.

16 THE PROBATION AGENT: It's November 26th.

17 THE COURT: Okay.

18 (Pause.)

19 THE COURT: Okay. So, he's got these pending. He's
20 pled to some. He had a hearing. He didn't show up.

21 MR. LITTLE: Your Honor, I think it's, it's clear that
22 some sort of revocation is in order at least to the old
23 charge -- of the old charge. We would ask respectfully for
24 90 days and terminate his probation. That way he at least
25 doesn't have two probation cases running simultaneously.

1 THE COURT: He's got five and -- ten years suspended to
2 five. He got five years over his head.

3 THE PROBATION AGENT: That's correct.

4 MR. LITTLE: I, I understand that, Your Honor.

5 THE COURT: But he's been in trouble. He hasn't done
6 what he's suppose to. He didn't show back up for the
7 hearing on the 13th .

8 MR. LITTLE: Respectfully, respectfully, Your Honor, I
9 would ask you to sentence him as if you were hearing this --
10 as if you were the sentencing judge hearing this de novo. I
11 understand it's, it's a little difficult without the
12 solicitor here to present their side of the events. But you
13 do have his criminal record.

14 THE COURT: I know. But that was the deal -- he had a
15 habitual offender.

16 MR. LITTLE: That's, that's correct.

17 THE COURT: And he pled to that.

18 MR. LITTLE: And he was, and he was---

19 THE COURT: And it's not a---

20 MR. LITTLE: ---sentenced to five years suspended, one
21 year of probation --

22 THE COURT: Right.

23 MR. LITTLE: -- which indicates to me, Your Honor, that
24 the solicitor did not deem that it was the worst offense in
25 the world. They were, they were willing to recommend

1 probation.

2 THE COURT: I understand that, but this offender wasn't
3 the worst offender in the world. It's contacting the victim
4 and not doing what he's suppose to, and not showing up to
5 the---

6 MR. LITTLE: Your Honor?

7 THE COURT: ---not showing up for the hearing on the
8 13th.

9 MR. LITTLE: Your Honor, we were suppose to have -- we
10 were suppose to have an admin -- we were suppose to have a
11 hearing on the 13th, that's true, an evidentiary hearing.
12 He didn't show up. I don't, I don't, I don't believe the
13 victim showed up either to testify in that.

14 THE COURT: I understand. So, I---

15 MR. LITTLE: We deny that allegation.

16 THE COURT: ---assume that the victim didn't show up,
17 that I'll give him the benefit, he didn't contact the
18 victim, but he didn't show up for the hearing.

19 MR. LITTLE: That's correct.

20 THE PROBATION AGENT: That's right. And I have another
21 affidavit as well, Your Honor, from the victim.

22 THE COURT: From the victim?

23 THE PROBATION AGENT: Yes.

24 THE COURT: I think he's in willful violation. I'm
25 gonna revoke three years and terminate him.

1 MR. LITTLE: Thank you, Your Honor.

2 THE PROBATION AGENT: Thank you, Your Honor.

3 THE DEFENDANT: I want a trial. Take a trial. No,
4 sir.

5 MR. LITTLE: All right. Thank you, Your Honor.

6 THE COURT: Okay.

7 THE DEFENDANT: We're going to trial. I want a trial.
8 I don't want to---

9 THE COURT: You ain't got no trial. You done had a
10 trial. You got 10 years hanging over you.

11 THE DEFENDANT: I, I already went across the water and
12 did three years. They didn't do anything, but I turned my
13 time for that.

14 THE COURT: I understand. You should of showed up on
15 the 13th.

16 THE PROBATION AGENT: Your Honor, can I put something
17 on the record?

18 THE DEFENDANT: I was in, I was in the hospital for the
19 13th.

20 THE PROBATION AGENT: Mr. Little?

21 MR. LITTLE: Yes, Your Honor.

22 THE PROBATION AGENT: Can you please inform your client
23 that he still has an outstanding probation case?

24 MR. LITTLE: Yes.

25 Beg the Court's indulgence.

1 Can we, can we go back on the record?

2 THE COURT: Okay.

3 MR. LITTLE: Are you, are you revoking his---

4 THE PROBATION AGENT: No.

5 THE COURT: Current probation that's in front of me.

6 MR. LITTLE: ---current one or both---

7 THE PROBATION AGENT: Just this.

8 THE COURT: No.

9 MR. LITTLE: Just this one?

10 THE COURT: Just the current one.

11 MR. LITTLE: Okay. When are we---

12 THE COURT: That's the only thing in front of me.

13 THE PROBATION AGENT: That's right.

14 MR. LITTLE: Okay. So, when he gets out---

15 THE COURT: The new one---

16 MR. LITTLE: ---he will go back on probation on the
17 other one?

18 THE COURT: Yeah.

19 THE PROBATION AGENT: For the offense that you've
20 referenced.

21 THE COURT: Yeah.

22 MR. LITTLE: Thank you.

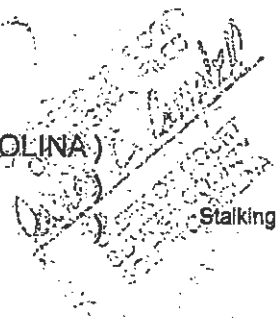

OF NOTICE

You are hereby directed to appear at a Probation/CSP Violation Hearing in General Sessions Court on 1-17-2020 at 9:00 (am/pm) in the Sumter County Courthouse, Sumter, South Carolina.

You may have an attorney represent you at this hearing. If you cannot afford an attorney and you desire the representation of the Sumter County Public Defender, you must apply for an appointed attorney with that office. If you choose to appear at the hearing without an attorney, you may be required to represent yourself. You are hereby advised that there are dangers and disadvantages to self representation. An attorney may better understand courtroom procedure and may be better able to think of and present defenses to your violations. By appearing without an attorney you are acknowledging these dangers but are knowingly and voluntarily choosing to proceed without counsel.

At the violation hearing you will have an opportunity to speak, and you may present witnesses or documentary evidence on your behalf. If requested, you will also have an opportunity to confront and cross-examine any witnesses called to testify against you; however, the Department may elect to present affidavits of witnesses or police officers in lieu of testimony. State v. Pauling (Ct. App. 2006). It is your responsibility to have your witnesses and attorney present. If you are released on bond prior to your hearing date, you must report to the Probation Office immediately upon your release.

You are required to be present at your hearing as scheduled above. If you do not appear, a bench warrant or a failure to appear warrant will be issued for your arrest. Furthermore, the Court may choose to proceed with the hearing in your absence. This directive remains in effect until you are granted leave by the Court.

This directive has been read to me and I have been provided with a copy. I was also given an opportunity to ask questions about this directive before it was signed.

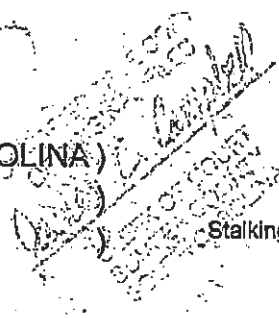

Mr. Singleton was referred to me **6/18/2018** by Agent Rhonda Brown. He had a previous case with us that was closed unsuccessfully due to him moving to Florence and not informing his Counselor in Sumter. I did his intake and he reported difficulties with an overactive thyroid and VR was to provide him with physical services and supports.

Since that time, he has missed several appointments in order to determine him eligible for our services, to develop a realistic work goal, as well as MH appointments set for him:

7/18/2018: Meeting to discuss medical records from SCDC and his report of back and neck problems while incarcerated. He did not show.

8/14/2018: Frazier was at Probation and I asked him about missed appointment. He denied knowing about any appointments.

8/23/2018: Appointment with Sumter Family Health Center. He reported difficulties with hyperthyroidism, chest pain, schizophrenia, multiple joint pain, and goiter.

9/26/2018: Medical appointment set for him for MH evaluation based on his report to Sumter Family Health Center of a schizophrenia diagnosis. He did not show.

10/3/2018: I left him a message about missing appointment. No response.
