Following a motions hearing on this matter on June 9, 2011, the Court issued an Order filed June 15, 2011, ordering the plaintiff to file with the Court and serve upon the defendants the Affidavit of a physician to support his claims of medical malpractice by Monday, August 8, 2011. The Order warned the plaintiff that if he failed to supply this Affidavit by August 8, 2011, the defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment would be granted and the plaintiff's case dismissed.
