**PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT AND
DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a **final thirty-day extension until December 21, 2020**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel respectfully shows the Court the following exigent circumstances:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed today having been extended by three prior orders of this Court.
2. Counsel filed the return to the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Renata Jones v. State in the Supreme Court on November 12, 2020. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Robert Miller, III with this Court on November 3, 2020. Counsel filed the petition

Counsel, along with co-counsel, filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Timothy Ray Jones, Jr. in the Supreme Court on October 23, 2020. Counsel filed an initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Calvin Ford in this Court on October 16, 2020. Counsel filed a petition for rehearing in the case of State v. John William McCarty in this Court on October 8, 2020. Counsel filed an initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Kayla Marie Cook in this Court on October 8, 2020. Counsel filed an Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter, and record on appeal in the case of State v. Jason Simmons in this Court on October 6, 2020. Counsel filed an amended initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Tony Orlanda Singleton in this Court on September 30, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Darryl Quan Damond Wilson in this Court on September 23, 2020. Counsel attended the Annual Public Defender Conference from September 21-23, 2020. Additionally, counsel presented on the topic of Practical Ethics for the Defense Bar on September 22, 2020, at the Conference. Not only was counsel's attendance at the Conference necessary in light of her presentation, but it was necessary for counsel to obtain her required continuing legal education hours. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Brian Neil White in this Court on September 21, 2020.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.




