





## ORDER

---

By order dated April 9, 2020, the South Carolina Public Service Commission (the Commission) denied a portion of the rate relief sought by Appellant. Appellant appealed the decision and filed a motion with the Commission for approval to implement the proposed rates under bond pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 58-5-240(D) (2015), which the Commission granted by order dated July 15, 2020. However, after a hearing on motions for clarification and rehearing, by order dated August 18, 2020, the Commission stayed the implementation of Appellant's proposed rates under bond.

Appellant has appealed the August 18, 2020 order and now asks this Court for a writ of supersedeas to allow it institute the proposed rates under bond pursuant to section 58-5-240(D). The petition for a writ of supersedeas is denied.
