ORDER

First, the request for an extension to serve and file the petitioner's brief and appendix is granted. Appellant shall serve and file petitioner's brief and appendix within thirty days of the date of this order.

Second, Petitioner's motion to expand the scope of the Supreme Court's order dated September 21, 2018, is denied. Third, Petitioner's motion for judicial notice is denied. Fourth, Petitioner's motion for appointment of standby or co-counsel is denied. Finally, because the petition for a writ of certiorari was granted only as to Issue Two—asking whether the post-conviction relief court erred by finding trial counsel was not ineffective for failing to provide adequate advice concerning his indictment for distribution of a controlled substance within proximity of school—Petitioner's motion for de novo review of novel questions of law and motion for certification of novel questions of law to the Supreme Court of South Carolina are denied.
