ORDER

First, Appellant's motion requesting this court to allow Appellant to include evidence to prove extrinsic fraud is denied.

Second Respondents' motion to require correction of the record on appeal is granted in its entirety. Appellant's request for an extension of time to cure the deficiencies is also granted. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file a record on appeal that complies with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
