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**RESPONDENT’S RETURN TO APPELLANT’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

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Pursuant to Rule 240(e), S.C.A.C.R., Respondent U.S. Bank, National Association, as trustee for the Holders of the Banc of America Funding Corporation 2008-FTI (“US Bank”) hereby files this Return to Appellant Rhonda Meisner’s (“Appellant”) Motion for Extension of Time to file the Record on Appeal, filed on November 12, 2020. US Bank objects to the requested extension of time. In this Court’s Order dated October 7, 2020, the Court granted Appellant until

November 12, 2020, to file the Record on Appeal and stated that no further extensions would be granted "absent extraordinary circumstances." Appellant's only reason for requesting the instant extension is that counsel for US Bank had informed her that she could eliminate a document from the record on appeal on the day the Record was due. However, this cannot constitute extraordinary circumstances because Appellant has been aware of US Bank's designation of matters to be included in the Record on Appeal since August 13, 2020, when US Bank served it and the fact that Appellant could eliminate a document that US Bank designated meant that it was actually easier for her to compile the Record as she presumably had access to all the other designated documents as of November 12, 2020. Accordingly, Appellant has failed to show extraordinary circumstances to warrant an extension to file the Record on Appeal and her Motion for Extension of Time should be denied.

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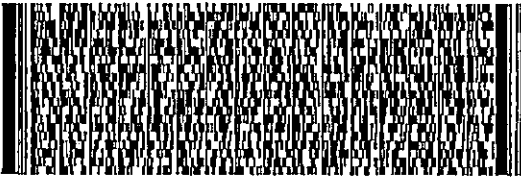
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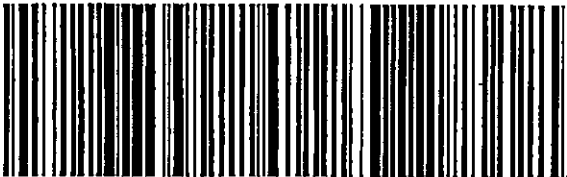


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
