RE: FOLLOW UP: response to letter dated 9 October 2020 regarding transcript for Alan Nix v. Sloan Law Firm, Appellate Case No. 2020-000676

Ms. Allen.

I left a letter at the Court of Appeals on 20 October 2020 related to your letter dated 9 October 2020 related to this situation. That letter requested a response explaining this situation within ten days of the date of the letter. Even if one were to liberally apply a calculation of ten days from 20 October 2020, the resulting date would be 30 October 2020. If one were to further liberally allow all ten days plus allow the court's explanation response to be mailed on the next business day, that would mean it would have been post marked and actually placed in the mail on Monday, 2 November 2020. Assuming the USPS took the entire week to get that letter from Columbia, SC to Mount Pleasant, SC, and allowing for me being delinquent in picking up my mail, etc., the court's explanation response to this situation would have certainly been in my USPS mail box at least by this past Monday, 9 November 2020.

However, I have yet to receive a response from the Court attempting to explain this situation.
