Dear Mr. Shearhouse,

SC Court of Appeals

Again thank you for your timely response, and I hope this correspondence finds you in good health and spirits.

Honorable Sir, something has happened that I feel has further added insult to my injury. It seems to me Horry County government officials have done everything possible to circumvent the law, my due process rights, and my right to equal protection. Please be patient with me while I elaborate.

First, on or about August 27, 2016 I was arrested on these charges, I was placed in jail and held without a bond, and without ever

seeing a judicial official what-so-ever until December 14, 2016. On that date I was finally allowed to see a judge. A \$35,000 bond was set and posted.

Subsequently, I failed to appear. A Governor's Warrant was issued, I was extradited back from Virginia in November of 2017. In January of 2018 I was released from custody on a written promise to appear. Solicitor Thomas Terrell III began to subpoena me to court for two weeks at a time every month, this continued every month until July of 2019. I appeared every time I was subpoenaed, and did so even in July of 2019. The records will verify this.

However, on July 23 I became violently sick due to opioid withdrawal and was physically unable to make it to court.

I was tried absentia on July 23 and 24 of 2019. Three completely unrelated charges were tried in front of one jury. I was found guilty, and a judgment was sealed.

On or about April 19, 2020 I filed a Motion For Mistrial.

On or about June 6, 2020 I filed a Motion For New Trial.

Because I could not get a hearing or ruling on either motion, and was being held without a release date or a bond, on June 25,

2020 I filed a Writ of Habeas Corpus in the Court of Appeals. On August 6, 2020 my writ of Habeas Corpus was returned to me.

Because I was still being held with no bond, no court date, and no release date I petitioned the Supreme Court for Certiorari.

Thereafter, as I previously informed the Court, on September 16, 2020 I appeared in Horry County Circuit Court, Judge William Seals presiding. He opened the sealed judgment and sentenced me to three 12 year sentences. He refused to allow me to speak or hear me on either my Motion For Mistrial or Motion For New Trial. On September 17, 2020 I gave notice of Appeal. Subsequently, on September 24, 2020 I filed a Motion To Reconsider or Consider.

Honorable Sir, here is the continuing problem. At the time I petitioned for certiorari the Motion For Mistrial and Motion For New Trial were and had been pending. They were pending on September 16, 2020 when Judge Seals refused to hear them and only sought to hear from the state and do its bidding.

However, on September 24, my notice of appeal, motion for appointment of counsel, and motion for transcripts was filed. Thereafter on November 3, 2020 Judge Steven John, (the same judge who communicated ex parte with

Solicitor, Thomas Terrell III and rescinded his order dated May 18, 2018) enters another order in this case. Judge John dismisses the Motion For Mistrial; Motion For New Trial; Motion For Standing And continued Objections; Motion For Appointment of Counsel; Motion For Transcripts; and Motion To Reconsider stating, "All pending motions are Dismissed until the jurisdiction is returned to the Court by the Appellate Court."

Honorable Sir, do I not have a due process right to be heard on these motions and to have them fairly adjudicated? Why was you not sent or notified of the pending motions? Enclosed is the November 3, 2020 Order entered by Judge John of which I speak. For a fact the Motion For Counsel and For Transcripts are also made in the Notice of Appeal. If the Circuit had no jurisdiction on any of those motions, how did Judge Seals have any jurisdiction on September 16, 2020 to open the sealed judgment.

Sir, I'm sorry if I sound skeptical, but I am. Why has all these officials done everything in their power to send me to prison for crimes I didn't commit? And why has everything been done to prevent me from being heard fairly in court? Isn't the manifest injustice manifested?

Sir, would you please inquire about what I'm asking. Also please return to me the enclosed order dated November 3, 2020 or a copy of it, I'm sorry but I am being denied the ability to make photocopies.

I'm not a lawyer sir, nor can I afford one, but I know something is very wrong. My forefathers did not die for this country so people could be treated this unfairly. Please look into this, it is certainly a very continuous pattern as manifested by the record. Thank you for your time and effort, and God Bless!
