**APPELLANTS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION TO SERVE
AND FILE INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, Appellants APTIM Federal Services, LLC, Employer, and XL Specialty Insurance Company, Carrier, hereby request a 30-day extension to serve and file their initial brief and designation of matter. The grounds for the Motion are as follows:

1. Appellants received the transcript from the lower court on November 29, 2020; therefore, Appellants' initial brief and designation of matter are due to be served and filed on December 29, 2020. *See* Rule 208(a)(1), SCACR; Rule 209(a), SCACR.
2. The December 29, 2020 deadline falls between the holiday season.

4. This extension requested, if granted, would make January 28, 2021 the new deadline for service and filing of Appellants' initial brief and designation of matter.
