ORDER

The South Carolina Court of Appeals denied the petition for a writ of certiorari in this post-conviction relief (PCR) case.¹ Petitioner has now filed a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the Court of Appeals. He also moves to hold in abeyance a Berkeley County Court of Common Pleas case pending the resolution of this matter.²

In *Ellison v. State*, 382 S.C. 189, 676 S.E.2d 671 (2009), this Court determined that it will no longer entertain petitions for writs of certiorari where the Court of Appeals has denied a petition for a writ of certiorari in a PCR case. Further, the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur on August 5, 2020, and denied petitioner's motion to recall the remittitur on September 2, 2020. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case, and no further motion or petition can be considered. *Stogsdill v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Human Servs.*, 415 S.C. 568, 784 S.E.2d 669 (2016); *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).

Accordingly, there is nothing for this Court to review, and the petition for a writ of certiorari and motion to hold in abeyance are dismissed and stricken.
