On November 23, 2020, I was removed off of Rhu Unit 13-Cell 262 from being on lockup for quarantine for testing positive for covid-19, to Disciplinary Detention based on the warden Gadsden orders in which my tablet which STL provide SCDC West law on it, was confiscated because inmates on disciplinary Detention on lockups can't have their tablets, radios, etc. I requested access to the computer that inmates on lockups are suppose to be able to use that provides us access to the courts. But it is very difficult in getting the officer to allow me to use the computer. I request access to, the officer says OK But never allows me to use it. on Dec 3, & 4, 2020 I and other inmates were moved from Rhu which is the upper yard to Rhl the lower yard. I was now live in Rhl Unit 12 cell 47. Still lockup. I haven't been charged with any SCDC policy violation, but I have been verbally told that is for violation of SCDC Policy 838 Solicitor of employees.

Now everything I need to be done (legal of concern stuff must be by paper request to staff from 1921), which must be placed in the mail box after being picked up by the officer, then picked up by the mail room clerk, and then delivered to the staff member the inmate request to staff is addressed to: mail by SCDC Policy they have 45 days to respond. Because of covid-19, staff is short, and it takes a while to receive legal material, access to factory, I just got my legal box back today and come to find out, my legal notes are missing. I need access to those papers and notes that were taken by mistake when Captain Moore searched my cell up in the upper yard on Nov 23 2020 when I was in the shower, he packed up my legal notebook and other legal material I need without consulting me to see if I needed it. Now I have to ask the Law Yard Rhl lockup where I am at now to go into my sealed duffel back where my property is and retrieve the rest of my legal material Captain Moore packed up. Things are very difficult and complicated, and

is reflecting my appellate Case 2020-001421. Did you ever get my Motion

requesting an ~~extra~~ extension of time to file my initial Briefs. I am also trying to get access to the computer so I can make sure I comply with SCA's. I don't want my appeal to be dismissed. I'm on lockdown discipling detentee, haven't received no notice of the change, nor been before a hearing adjustment committee and found guilty, but been on ~~lockdown~~ a charge? 15 days none site NOV 23 2020. Even if I'm innocent, Burner Thomas will find me guilty, because, the warden has already found me guilty and put me on lockdown for punishment without affording me due process. If you call SCDC Tyger River Corr Inst, ask who is connected to Rhk Unit 12 and call the commandery. Also what is Robert Watkins 243803 on ~~lockdown~~ lockdown for they will tell you they don't know. Because the paper work hasn't been processed, I haven't been convicted of anything and sentenced to discipling detentee, yet I'm here. And this interferes with me being able to file my initial Briefs as required by SCA's.

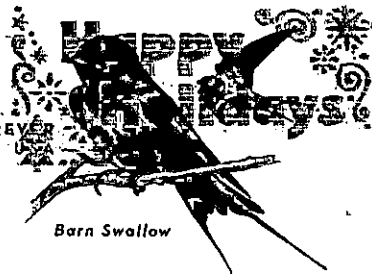
